

NBRC Towing Expenses

The allowance for towing to regattas is to compensate the tower for the additional cost of fuel and wear and tear, above the normal cost of driving.

The allowance is to be calculated at 35 pence per mile.

The tower should expect to collect normal fuel contributions from passengers in the towing vehicle.

The allowance will be divided between all adults entering the regatta, including the tower.

All adults entered must pay, even if they withdraw within a week of the event.

Juniors will be excluded from the calculation and will not be charged (they will have to pay the cost of towing to junior only regattas).

The Captain should appoint a senior Club member to collect the money and the money should be passed to the tower on the day.
